Fall Curbside Pick-Up is Monday, October 14th!



Items must be placed out on the curb no later than 6am on Monday and must be manageable by one person and weigh less than 100 pounds. **EXCLUDED items include appliances, tires, electronics, chemicals, batteries, paint and loose construction materials.** If you need the above items picked up you will need to call Advanced Disposal at 608-251-7878 to arrange for them to pick up at an extra cost.

Making Payments

Water/Sewer Bills may be paid several ways:

 - A) Follow steps using the Payment Service Network (PSN)
 - B) Checking, Savings or Credit Card*
 - *A convenience fee of 2.75% will be applied to credit card payments.
 - *An additional fee of 50¢ is applied for payments below \$100.
 - C) You also have the option to enroll in paperless billing.

If you'd like your tax payment receipted in 2019, just have it postmarked by Dec. 31st, or in our drop box available at the front door of the Village Hall.

YARD WASTE PICK UP



- ◇ Brush, leaves and grass shall be placed in the curb (on the street), not on the tree bank.
- ◇ From May 1st-September 30th leaves and grass clippings must be placed in a container **with a lid**, not to exceed 75 pounds.
- ◇ We will continue to pick up yard waste and brush (NO TREES) on Monday, but will only be picking up yard waste and brush as time allows on Fridays.
- ◇ Have your material in the curb no later than 6:30 AM on Monday's or it may not get picked up.

If you hire a contractor to mow grass or cut brush or trees they are responsible for the removal of such.

WINTER PARKING REGULATIONS

Alternate Side Parking:

Beginning December 1, up to and including March 15, vehicles may be parked on the even numbered side of the street on those nights which, at 1:00 a.m., bear an even calendar date, and on the odd numbered side of the street on those nights which, at 1:00 a.m., bear an odd calendar date.



Friendly Reminder

The State of Wisconsin requires all dogs to be licensed. Licenses run on a calendar year. If a dog is not licensed by **March 31st**, the owner will incur a \$5.00 late fee. To license a dog, proof of rabies vaccination must be provided; including Veterinarian, Expiration Date, Manufacturer and Serial Number of Vaccine.

License Fees:

- \$7 for spayed or neutered
- \$12 if not spayed or neutered

It's impossible to sum up all that's special about Baraboo in a logo and a three-word slogan, but we gave it a shot. And we love the result.

Five partners – the City, the Village of West Baraboo, the Baraboo Area Chamber of Commerce, Downtown Baraboo Inc. and the Business Improvement District – joined forces this year to create a brand for the Baraboo Area. The goal was to develop a consistent message all stakeholders could use to promote the community. The result was the "Discover Real Baraboo" brand.

The House United, a consulting firm, was hired to help develop the brand, in tandem with a committee of local leaders. While it was challenging to fit all of Baraboo's wonders – breathtaking natural areas, fascinating historical sites, groundbreaking conservation groups and unique shopping opportunities – into a single slogan, the theme of authenticity leapt to the forefront again and again. Hence the "Discover Real Baraboo" slogan.

A logo depicting that slogan, as well as an accompanying color scheme and secondary logos, were developed and now rest in stakeholders' hands. Baraboo Area businesses can now incorporate the brand into their own marketing, creating cohesive messaging. Soon every event poster, parade banner and roadside sign will carry elements of the brand, creating an unmistakable trademark. You'll know it's from Baraboo when you see the "Discover Real Baraboo" slogan and the signature "B."
