SHAW STREET RECONSTRUCTION

The contract with MSA was approved at the last meeting. Since then, MSA has completed the topographic survey and began working on preliminary plans.

LINN STREET/STH 33 UTILITIES RECONSTRUCTION

MSA completed the record drawings, as-built survey, GIS updates and has some minor closeout documentation to complete.

LOCUST AND HILL STREETS RECONSTRUCTION

Work for this project has been completed. MSA plans to complete the 12-month warranty review in the late summer of 2025.

PRAIRIE HILL VILLAGE DEVELOPMENT (1850 W PINE STREET)

Recent work generally included installation of building foundations, under-slab piping, and water and sewer utility installations. Six of the 10 buildings have drywall installed to date. Watermain installation has been completed.

A meeting was held on-site on December 5 to discuss screening along the boundaries of the property.

The first building will be ready for temporary occupancy in January. This building will be used as office space and a showroom for prospective tenants. The first units are expected to be occupied in February 2025.

PROJECT UPDATE

VILLAGE FOREST PARK

All work under Phase 2 and 3 has been completed.

MSA continues to evaluate potential funding opportunities for future phases of the Park including the following:

- WisDOT Transportation Alternatives Program (TAP) – Deadline to apply is October 2025
- Non-State Grant Program – Funding for future funding cycles has not yet been determined
- WDNR Knowles-Nelson Stewardship Program – Deadline to apply is May 1, 2025
- WDNR Recreational Trails Program (RTP) - Deadline to apply is May 1, 2025

ZAJACK TRAIL RECONSTRUCTION

Water and Sewer Mapping Application

MSA completed setting up the water and sanitary sewer mapping applications, and training has been completed.

FUNDING ADMINISTRATION

Linn Street/STH 33 CDBG

MSA is nearing completion of the funding administration, and plans to have the CDBG funding closed out by the end of 2024. \$1.0 million was awarded and \$975,000 has been disbursed. CDBG holds the final \$25,000 of the grant until the project is closed out. All grant requirements have been met, except file monitoring and project completion paperwork.
